

## British Army Succession of Titles: Logistics



The Royal Logistic Corps was formed on 5th April 1993 through the amalgamation of the Royal Corps of Transport, the Royal Army Ordnance Corps, the Royal Pioneer Corps, the Army Catering Corps, and the Postal and Courier branch of the Royal Engineers, bringing under one cap badge many of the British Army's principal transport, supply, ordnance, labour, catering and postal services.

This document traces the complex lineage of those constituent organisations and their predecessors, many of which evolved through repeated reforms, redesignations and consolidations over several centuries. In order to preserve clarity and maintain a direct regimental line of descent, subordinate Battalions, Groups, Depots, Ordnance Field Parks and Ordnance Maintenance Parks have been included only where they were subsequently redesignated or elevated as Regiments, and thus formed a continuing part of the wider regimental succession represented within this document.
